## TOPICS IN 2018

**Getting to the Root of It** - Fertilizer placement, root growth, and how we can impact what goes on beneath our feet.

**What is Your Soil Trying to Tell You?** - Is there something holding your crop back? Is it a pest or fertility—or perhaps something deeper?

**Winter Wheat Disease Management** - Fusarium head blight, strip rust and more; hear the latest on managing those tough wheat diseases both in the field and in the bin.

**Fungicide and Low-Lignin Alfalfa** - Take a look at these tools separately and together, and discuss when and how they might fit into alfalfa production systems.

**Herbicide Injury** - A hands-on look at herbicide injury in corn and soybeans.

**Compaction COSTS!** - Diagnosing, minimizing, and managing compaction

**Picket Fence Corn, What About Soybeans?** - Is plant to plant variability and picket fence stands as important for soybeans as they are in corn.

**Early Soybean Growth and Development** - How management decisions such as fertility, variety, and planting date impact soybean's full yield potential.

**Western Bean Cutworm** - Hone your scouting skills and learn about important management strategies.

**Nitrogen Whisperers** - Nitrates? Rainfall? Recent research and thought processes around cues to aid in-season N rate adjustments.

**Disease Management** - What's going on with diseases in 2018 and beyond!

## EOCDD

The diagnostic day is designed specifically to improve the problem-solving skills of growers, agricultural consultants and seed, fertilizer and chemical industry personnel.

The Eastern Ontario Crop Diagnostic Day will provide growers and agri-business personnel with “hands-on” learning experiences to assist with the correct identification and treatment of crop problems common to eastern Ontario. The program will provide a “real-world” environment where agriculturists can hone their crop troubleshooting skills and evaluate new and alternative management strategies.

This is the 21st annual Eastern Ontario Crop Diagnostic Day that will highlight current topics of interest. The long-term goal of the day is to provide quality, state-of-the-art training in all aspects of crop production and management.

To facilitate discussion with speakers, participants will be divided into small groups of about 20 people. Each group will rotate through each location. Staff from the Ontario Ministry of Agriculture, Food and Rural Affairs and University of Guelph will conduct these sessions.
